




Your HTC Desire U dual sim

Inserting your SIM and microSD cards

IMPORTANT: USE A REGULAR SIM (miniSIM) WITH THIS PHONE. If you have a smaller size SIM (such as a microSIM), make sure you insert it with a SIM adapter. Do not directly insert a smaller size SIM into the slot.

1. Open the back cover from the small opening at the bottom.
2. Insert a WCDMA or GSM SIM into the slot labeled SIM 1, with the card's gold contacts facing down and cut-off corner facing in. When using a microSIM card, make sure the adapter fits into the slot. Do not force it, or you may damage the slot. Switch to a thinner adapter if it doesn't fit properly.
3. You can only insert a GSM SIM in the slot labeled SIM 2.
4. Insert a microSD card into the storage card slot with its gold contacts facing down until it clicks into place.
5. To replace the back cover, align the back cover onto the top part of the phone first, and then press the sides and the bottom part of the back cover down to lock the cover into place.

Charge the battery

The battery in your phone hasn't been charged yet. Please use the supplied power adapter to do a full charge before you start using your phone. Also, please don't try to take your phone apart. (If you do, it may invalidate your warranty.)

Choose a rate plan wisely

Depending on how you use your phone, it can use up a lot of Internet bandwidth really quickly. Before you use your phone, we strongly recommend that you contact your mobile operator about data rates.

Using data services while roaming will be costly. Check with your mobile operator for data roaming rates before you use data roaming.

Know about privacy laws


