




# Your HTC Desire XC dual sim

## Inserting your SIM and microSD cards


### IMPORTANT: USE REGULAR UIM AND SIM CARDS.

If you have a smaller size SIM (such as a microUIM or microSIM), make sure you insert it with a SIM adapter. Do not directly insert a smaller size SIM into the slot.



1. Open the back cover from the small opening at the bottom of the phone.
2. Make sure to remove the battery before inserting the UIM and SIM cards.
3. Insert a CDMA UIM card into the left slot, with its gold contacts facing down and cut-off corner facing out. Insert a GSM SIM card into the right slot. When using a microSIM card, make sure the adapter fits into the slot. Do not force it, or you may damage the slot. Switch to a thinner adapter if it doesn't fit properly.

4. Insert your microSD card into the storage card slot with its gold contacts facing down and push it all the way in.
5. Reinsert the battery.



6. Align the back cover to the top of the phone. Then press the sides and the bottom part of the back cover down to lock the cover into place.

# Read this first

## Charge the battery

The battery in your phone hasn't been charged yet. Please use the supplied power adapter to do a full charge before you start using your phone. Also, please don't try to take your phone apart. (If you do, it may invalidate your warranty.)

## Choose a rate plan wisely

Depending on how you use your phone, it can use up a lot of Internet bandwidth really quickly. Before you use your phone, we strongly recommend that you contact your mobile operator about data rates.

Using data services while roaming will be costly. Check with your mobile operator for data roaming rates before you use data roaming.

## Know about privacy laws

Some countries have strict laws about how and when you can record phone conversations. It's a good idea to find out what the laws are where you live before you use your phone's recording feature.


